LETTER FROM THE DIRECTORS:

Salutations, fellow BBIs!

The Blue Blaze Irregulars, the Official Buckaroo Banzai Fan Club, began with a single fan letter received in August of 1984. Now there are over 3,500 of you out there, scattered across the United States and the rest of the world, from Canada to Australia and from England to Pakistan. We have received letters from people deeply involved with science fiction/fantasy/media fandom, and letters from people who say they've never joined a fan club before. We've received multi-page, in-depth critiques of the film from some fans, while others have had to dictate their brief messages to Mom, Dad or an older sibling. On homemade stationery and professional letterhead, often in wildly decorated envelopes, we've received letters, photos, drawings, puzzles, cryptic messages, Lectroid food and all manner of speculation on "Why is there a watermelon there?"

The answer to that question will be in the second issue of World Watch One, the BBI Newsletter, which we had hoped to have in your hands by now. However, as we warned you before, we are the Blue Blaze Irregulars; also, as John Lennon reminds us all, life is what happens to you when you're busy making other plans. We each have full-time jobs with awkward schedules, and over fifty miles of heavy traffic separate SF and Hollywood from Catnip and Illinois Kate, while the entire continent lies between the four of us and Sunshine and D.J. World Watch One (2) will be mailed in March (believe it!). By way of compensation for the delay, we are sending out this abbreviated bulletin to bring you up-

They offer t-shirts and jerseys, with more memorabilia in the works, so check out their designs for the latest in strike team activewear. We've updated our list of current film and television projects involving members of Team Richter for your perusal. In the interests of equal opportunity fandom, we've included information on the League of Lectroids for Lizardo, and a BBI who wants to get in touch with Texas fans. You'll also find information on some upcoming 20th Century Fox films that might interest you.

Thank you for returning your BBI Questionnaires! The information is being computer-catalogued for Team Richter by Sunshine and D.J., using a program similar to the one they devised to log Pinky Carruthers' 47,000 unknown facts. These data should prove useful when/if "Buckaroo Banzai Against the World Crime League" goes into production. Since you've been kind enough to tell us so much about yourselves, we feel we should reciprocate by telling you a little more about the Blue Blaze Irregulars and your Directors.

The BBIs (named after the B. Banzai fan club described in the novel "The Adventures of Buckaroo Banzai") began in August 1984 when Dianne Wickes (Hollywood), a secretary in the feature publicity department of 20th Century Fox, started to answer fan mail the studio was receiving about "TABB." Terry Erdmann (Silver Fox), a publicist handling Fox's science fiction/fantasy films, began helping out as the mail increased. In September, while working at the 1984 World Science Fiction Convention, Hollywood met Denise Tathwell (Catnip), a registered nurse, who rapidly became the "Mrs. Johnson" of the West Coast Offices. Catnip recruited Lori Oberscheven (Illinois Kate), assistant payroll supervisor for a group of hospitals; Fern Marder (Sunshine) and Carol Walske (D.J.), our computer experts, signed on shortly thereafter. We are all in our thirties, more or less, and are all women (SF being the definite exception). We enjoy science fiction, fantasy and action/adventure, are long-time film fans, and we love rock 'n roll (although our tastes vary widely) and many other kinds of music. And, of course, we each found a lot to enjoy in "TABB."

The Blue Blaze Irregulars were founded and exist:

- 1) To respond to inquiries about "The Adventures of Buckaroo Banzai" with printed material about the film, the characters and the world of Buckaroo Banzai.
- 2) To research and demonstrate support for "The Adventures of Buckaroo Banzai" and "Buckaroo Banzai Against the World Crime League."

Legal, financial and other restrictions placed on us by our sponsors, 20th Century Fox and Sherwood Productions, preclude charging fees or providing services other than those above. The promotional material we send out was produced for the original publicity campaign for "TABB," and unfortunately, we are not funded to replace items such as pins, stickers, headbands, etc., once we have run out. Therefore, the Blue Blaze Irregulars could probably be better described as an activity-oriented mailing list rather than a fan club.

However, that has not stopped us from organizing a few local activities for L.A. area fans, and we encourage you to do the same in your communities. We've greatly enjoyed the friendships we've formed through our work with the BBIs, and would like all of you to have the chance to get to know one another as well. The response to our inquiry in the BBI Questionnaire about a "pen pal" list was very positive, so enclosed you will find your BBI Directory Listing Form. If you would like to participate, please return the completed form to us as soon as possible, so we may compile the first edition of the BBI Directory and mail it with World Watch One (2) in March. Any listings received too late to be included in the first Directory will be included in supplements accompanying future newsletters.

As mentioned earlier, we will be sharing the most creative answers to "Why is there a watermelon there?" with you in the next issue of WW1. Interestingly, we received a number of equally creative answers to the question, "Why are Rawhide, Sam and McIlvaine still there?" We will include those responses (as well as our own explanation) in WW1(2), too, along with more anecdotes about life at the Banzai Institute. We've heard rumors of B. Banzai publications other than our own, and will gladly print the addresses of any we discover so that you may contact them directly (if you know of any, please drop us a line). If you'd like to submit material to WW1, we'll accept it in almost any form, provided it's brief, readable and Reno doesn't think it's too dirty. We promise to read everything, but we don't promise to print it.

A number of you have written the Institute and offered to distribute flyers for the Blue Blaze Irregulars. Many members have found us through your work, and we thank you. Also, a few of you have copied the BBI Questionnaire and distributed it. Although we appreciate your efforts, this makes us crazy because we can't be certain who has already written to us and received their introductory membership packet and who has not. It also cheats the tally of support letters for B. Banzai. Therefore, we've enclosed a copy of our flyer for you to copy and give to your friends instead. If you need a large number of flyers, just contact us and we'll send them to you.

It's been a long year of gathering in Building 89 at the Fox studio on Sunday afternoons to eat Kentucky Fried Chicken and run thousands of Xerox copies, stuff and type labels for hundreds of envelopes, and write scores of letters. We've enjoyed it all, though, and we plan on continuing as long as there is interest in Buckaroo Banzai, his friends and his adventures. We are, after all, a growing excited fan club.




